

School Times

It is important that children arrive at school punctually. Lessons begin promptly and children can miss vital information if they are late. Any latecomers must always report to the school office so that their attendance can be registered. The school day starts at 8.55am for Key Stage One and for Key Stage 2.

8.55am -12.15pm	Morning session of lesson
10.15am - 10.30am	Break
12.00 - 1.15pm	Lunch – Reception
12.15 - 1.15pm	Lunch – KS1
12.30 - 1.30pm	Lunch – KS2
1.15/1.30pm - 3.20/3.25pm	Afternoon session of lessons (No afternoon break)

Children should not arrive at school too early in the morning, as they are not normally allowed in the school building until the bell goes, unless there are exceptional weather conditions. Parents need to be aware that the playground is only supervised from 8.45am so it is unwise for children to arrive earlier. It is essential that children use the correct paths and entrances. Parents are not allowed to drive onto the school property without a special permit.

We are very security conscious at the school, and the only entry point for visitors leads into the reception lobby at the main entrance. We request that parents remain in this area until one of our office staff becomes free to attend to them. Access beyond this point is regulated by a security fob. All other entrances are security locked under the same system.
