

## Primary Sports & PE Funding 2017-2018

At Wrotham Road School, we believe that PE and Sport play an important role in allowing the children to develop the essential qualities of discipline, resilience, communication and team work and to encourage them to lead healthy and active lifestyles.

We will give children a basic grounding in all the desired outcomes with a view to their continuing involvement in and enthusiasm for secondary school PE, taking this into their adult lives.

### **What is Primary PE and Sports Premium?**

The PE and Sports Premium is provided to help primary schools improve the quality of the PE and sports activities they offer to pupils. The funding can only be spent on the provision of PE and sports in schools.

Wrotham Road has been allocated **£19,540** for this academic year. Below is a breakdown of how we have decided to use this funding.

Cyclopark – CycloTutor sessions - Year 3 and 6 120 pupils to receive 6 weeks worth of cycling training	£2,500
Swimming lesson – Top up and catch up lessons	£5,000

Sports affiliations football KS2	£60
Cyber coach	£350
Subsidised After school Club Provision – Street dance	£1,400
Subsidised After school Club Provision – Fun Fitness	£300
PE sports equipment	£500
PE specialist teacher	£15,000
Sports Day	£200
<b>Total</b>	<b>£25,850</b>

Possible additional uses of the funding this year will include:

- Hiring specialist PE teachers or qualified sports coaches to work with primary teachers when teaching PE
- Supporting and engaging the least active children through new or additional Change4Life clubs
- Paying for professional development opportunities for teachers in PE and sport
- Providing cover to release primary teachers for professional development in PE and sport
- Running sport competitions, or increasing pupils' participation with other schools
